NOTES ON REPORTING

My research for Team of Five took me from a candid conversation with President Donald Trump in the Oval Office to a visit with Jimmy and Rosalynn Carter in their modest living room in Plains, Georgia. I interviewed more than a hundred presidential aides, family members, White House residence staff, and former first ladies and vice presidents. When aides asked to talk on background because of the confidential nature of some of these conversations, I respected their wishes. This is an especially sensitive story that is unfolding every day in unexpected ways. Accounts of life as a former president were supplemented by extensive research from archival materials, including oral histories from presidential libraries; memoirs penned by former presidents and first ladies, residence staffers, and political aides; and biographies. I especially want to thank the Miller Center at the University of Virginia for the incredible work they do documenting what really happens inside the West Wing.
